Peace 	<p>The introduction is designed to help student review the storyline of the Bible. In reviewing the storyline of the Bible I will attempt to help students understand God's mission to restore the world to its intended wholeness. I will also introduce an illustration that will help the readers make sense of the story and mission of the Bible through four main areas: (1) God, (2) Self, (3) Others and (4) the World. I also hope to help the readers redefine "peace" and tie it to the way they choose to live their lives.</p>
Part 1: God	<p>Peace with God</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Seeking God b. Way of Life 	<p>This section of the book is designed to help the readers construct a way or "rule" of life. The rule of life is intended to help the readers surrender to God and find a peaceful rhythm in which to live a whole life.</p>
Part 2: Self	<p>Peace with Self</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Identity b. Calling 	<p>This section intends to help the reader more deeply understand who they are and how they are called to live their life as participants in God's mission.</p>
Part 3: Others	<p>Peace with Others</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Relationships b. Gospel of: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Justice ii. Salvation 	<p>Section 3 will stress the importance of relationships with humanity and also attempt to bring a greater context to the mission of God through the embodiment of the gospel.</p>
Part 4: World	<p>Peace with the World</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Activism b. Environmental Stewardship 	<p>This section will attempt to help the reader see themselves as activists who are called to care for the world through ecological</p>

		stewardship and holiness.
Journal: 28 Days	Week 1: Seeking God Week 2: Who am I, really? Week 3: Sharing the Gospel Week 4: Changing the World!	This final section is a practical 28-day journey in which the readers will be challenged to journal their life. Hopefully this section will also help the reader to develop a way of life that guides them toward deeper levels of union with God, self, others and the world.
